COUNCILLOR COMMENT-

I recently held discussions with the General Manager, Sunshine Coast Airport, Mr Peter Pallot, who is now also responsible for the Caloundra Aerodrome .

A number of ongoing issues in relation to the Caloundra Aerodrome were discussed and we plan to achieve the following outcomes:

- Review of the Caloundra Aerodrome Fly Neighbourly Policy, which includes

separate policies for Helicopter Operations and Fixed Wing Operations. The existing Fly Neighbourly Agreement was adopted by the former Caloundra City Council on 24 March 1999. It was put together by the Caloundra Airport Users Committee.

- Form a new Caloundra Aerodrome Liaison Group, to include interested residents, community associations, industry representatives and council

staff. I will also attend these meetings. For us all to live alongside each other, it is essential to both understand the operations of the Caloundra Aerodrome and the businesses currently operating out of there as well as a reciprocal arrangement between the Airport and community. We can also develop protocols around noise complaints and flight paths.
