FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Wow, what a wet May it has been! Bellvista recorded huge rainfall totals at 509mm during May 19th – 21st. With the amount of rain, our local stormwater system couldn't cope. Access to the estate was cut one night and the usual areas (the road to the school) went under first. It's a timely reminder that we need to think before driving through flooded streets. Some residents experienced water across their property and homes.

Please remember to call the SES (132500) in a storm and flood emergency situation, or in **life threatening** situations call the Queensland Fire and Rescue Ser-

vice, Police or Ambulance (000).

Given all the rain also, the April weather event caused some problems for residents over in Grampion Drive and Griffen Crescent with a sewage spill. BeCA has been in constant contact with Council and they have undertaken works on the pump stations involved.

Council conveyed to BeCA that even in extreme weather events the pumping station can still fail. With the last rain, residents have reported no issues with water backing up in their toilets. Great work in Council fixing the problem promptly! A note on this, if

you see the yellow flashing light going at the pumping stations, please inform the Council as soon as possible.
